Faculty and Graduate Student Behavioral Decision Making Grants - Small grants of up to \$3000 are available to support behavioral decision making (BDM) research at Ohio State. The goal of these competitive grants is to foster new BDM research activity and collaboration. Priority will be given to (a) projects that bring together BDM researchers from different departments or researchers who have not previously collaborated, (b) seed projects that are likely to generate pilot data or theory for external grant proposals, (c) projects that allow for the meaningful involvement of graduate and undergraduate students, and (d) projects by researchers who have not been previously funded under this program.
